Booking an appointment and safety protocol



BOOKING ESSENTIAL



MASK REQUIRED

Mpox (Monkeypox) is a contagious disease that requires careful safety and infection control measures during testing to prevent the spread of the disease.

PathWest ensures patients and staff safety by following strict safety protocols. To prepare for your visit and safeguard your health and the health of others, it is essential to schedule an appointment for your mpox testing prior to attending a PathWest collection centre, and follow the safety protocols when visiting us.

If a collection centre near you does not provide mpox testing

Please do not attend a collection centre without an appointment. If you arrive at a collection centre that cannot perform mpox testing, or you have not made an appointment, you will be redirected or advised to contact your referring doctor.

Your safety protocol when entering a collection centre

To protect yourself and others, please follow these safety and infection control measures:

1. Before entering

- Wear a surgical mask throughout your visit.
- If you are unwell, coughing, or unable to tolerate wearing a mask, please do not attend a centre. Contact your doctor to discuss alternative test arrangements.

2. During your visit

- Follow all instructions from PathWest staff and avoid unnecessary contact with surfaces.
- Test collections will only occur in designated rooms within the centre. Testing will not be performed outside the centre (e.g. carparks).

3. After your visit

- If you used any facilities during your visit (e.g. toilets), these areas will be cleaned thoroughly according to infection control protocols.
