

Midstream urine sample collection

NO BOOKING REQUIRED





If the urine sample is not refrigerated or there is a delay in delivering it to PathWest, bacteria in the sample can multiply. This can affect your results and you may be asked to repeat the test.



You should have been provided with a sterile container for your sample. If the container is broken or you have touched the inside surface, please request a new container.

- Wash your hands with soap and water and dry them before taking your sample.
- 2. Label the container with your **full name**, date of birth and the date and time of collection.
- 3. **Females:** Sit astride the toilet and cleanse your vagina from front to back with a clean wipe.

Males: Cleanse your penis with a clean wipe. If uncircumcised, retract your foreskin and cleanse.

- 4. Begin urinating into the toilet. After 3 seconds, position the container in the urine stream for 4-6 seconds or until it is **10-20ml** filled, then remove the container and continue urinating into the toilet.
- 5. Seal the container securely to prevent leaks. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.

Sample handling, storage and delivery

If you are at a collection centre

Place the container into the plastic bag provided and hand it to a staff member.

If you are collecting a sample at home

Deliver it to a PathWest collection centre within one hour. If immediate delivery is not possible, store the sample in the refrigerator (not freezer) for up to 12 hours in an additional sealed bag.
