



Specimen Collection Swab Guide

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General instructions



- Label swabs with patient's full name, date of birth, anatomical collection site, and date/time of collection
- Multiple swabs are required when tests from multiple categories are requested
- Check expiry date of swabs prior to collection
- Ensure lid is firmly placed on all specimens.

 Microscopy, culture and sensitivities (MC&S) general bacterial/fungal testing (including Group B Strep) Excludes: Chlamydia, Mycoplasma, Trichomonas. For microscopy, use a separate swab to collect the sample then smear it onto a glass slide. Put the slide in a plastic slide container and send it to the lab. This isn't needed for nose, throat, or rectal swabs For Neisseria gonorrhoeae culture, only Amies Charcoal or Amies Gel swabs are suitable. 	Amies Charcoal Swab OR Amies Gel Swab	Dry, plastic, or metal shaft with synthetic fibre tip	Swabs containing universal / viral transport medium
 Multi-resistant organism screen (excluding Candida auris) Includes: MRSA, CRO/CPO, VRE, CRE/CPE Slide for microscopy not required. 	Amies Charcoal Swab OR Amies Gel Swab	Dry, plastic, or metal shaft with synthetic fibre tip OR Dry Double Swab	Swabs containing universal / viral transport medium
