

Western Australian COVID-19 Immunity Collaborative (WACIC) Biobank

Biobank Application Fees

The WACIC Biobank has been funded by the Department of Health to establish a core repository of biological specimens and clinical data, with a primary aim of facilitating Western Australian research into SARS-CoV-2 immunity.

The access fees stated below are subject to change and dependent on cost recovery requirements necessary to ensure the longevity of the biobank.

WA Health associated projects

Participant de-identified biological specimens will be retrieved by WACIC laboratory staff at no cost to the approved research or GEKO project where the lead applicant is a WA health system staff employee and/or a WA health system entity is the project sponsor.

Non-WA Health associated projects

Approved research projects led by academic or medical research institutes will be charged a nominal fee to access the biobank that will assist with cost recovery for associated sample and data collection, storage and release.
